

"How to Explain and Defend the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist"

According to an alarming 1992 Gallup poll, the majority of Catholics seem to be confused in their beliefs about Christ's presence in the Eucharist. In fact, only 30% of those polled believe they are really and truly receiving the body, blood, soul and divinity of the Lord Jesus Christ under the appearance of bread and wine.
